



#EU4ME ILLUSTRATION CONTEST

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Delegation of the European Union to Indonesia (hereinafter referred to as “the EU Delegation”) is launching an illustration contest themed “EU4ME” (hereinafter referred to as “contest”) and published on the website: www.eu4mecontest.web.id

1. THEME OF THE CONTEST

Theme: EU4ME

How would you describe the EU?

Express through digital artwork or illustration the following: “For me, the EU is ...”

2. ELIGIBILITY OF CONTESTANTS

- a. This contest is open to Indonesian citizens domiciled in Indonesia and age 18-30 years old.
- b. A contestant is allowed to submit a maximum of 3 (three) artworks.
- c. Only individual entry is accepted. Collaboration or group or community entries are not eligible.

3. ELIGIBLE ENTRY

- a. The artwork(s) must reflect the theme of the contest.
- b. The artwork(s) must be original, unpublished and unproduced. Any piece posted or shared online, anywhere other than personal social media accounts or blog, is considered published, and will not be eligible.
- c. The artwork(s) that have been submitted to other contests or has been previously exhibited or sold are not acceptable. We reserve the right to request proof that an entry is the original photo of the contestant and submitted solely by the contestant for this contest. Non-compliance to this rule will result in disqualification of the entry.
- d. The artwork(s) cannot contain third party copyright logos or material and must not violate the rights of any person or entity; including copyright, privacy, or any other intellectual property rights. Upon submitting artwork(s) to this contest, the contestant is solely responsible for any infringement of copyrighted materials.
- e. The artwork submissions must not contain inappropriate, offensive, discriminatory, sexual, or unlawful materials. The artwork(s) deemed inappropriate will be disqualified.
- f. The artwork(s) must be the contestant’s original concept – plagiarism or “sampling” of any kind is not accepted and will result in disqualification of the entry.

4. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- a. The artwork(s) entries must not have watermarks, timestamps, date stamps, or borders.
- b. The artwork(s) must be in square format (1:1 ratio).
- c. The submission of the artwork should be digital format.
- d. File types accepted: .jpg .pdf.
- e. Size - resolution 1080 x 1080 pixels and 300 ppi (minimum).
- f. File names should be in the following format: name_city_artwork#
- g. Participants should be prepared to submit the original file in higher resolution in case the artwork is chosen as a winner.
- h. Submit your entries online via www.eu4mecontest.web.id

- i. Entry must include a completed “Entry Form” and a copy of a valid ID card.
- j. Entries that do not adhere to the rules described above will be disqualified.

5. JUDGING

- a. Winners will be decided by the EU Delegation based on:
 - Adherence to the theme and rules of the contest
 - Interpretation of the theme
 - Concept
 - Creativity
 - Composition
- b. The decision is final.

6. PRIZES

- a. 12 units of smart tablet for 12 winners
- b. Under no circumstances may the prizes be subject to change or alteration at the request of the contestants.

7. KEY DATES

- a. The contest is launched on Monday, 25 April 2022.
- b. Deadline: Entries must be submitted no later than **Friday, 27 May 2022** at 10 PM (Jakarta Time, GMT+7).
- c. The EU Delegation will announce the winners on the contest website on **Friday, 17 June 2022**. The EU Delegation will also contact each winner at the email address provided in the entry form.
- d. The EU Delegation reserves the right to modify the dates and announce it in a timely manner on the contest website.

8. ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS

- a. By entering the contest, the contestant confirms that they hold all intellectual property rights in the artwork(s).
- b. Without prejudice to the Terms and Conditions, the EU Delegation recognises that the copyright in the artwork(s) created by the contestant remains with the contestant. Any enquiries for copyright will be referred to the contestant. However, by entering to the contest, the contestant grants the EU Delegation a non-exclusive, non-profit ad royalty-free right of use, dissemination, distribution, public communication, reproduction and exhibition of the artwork(s) submitted without prior notice.
- c. Credit/acknowledgement of the contestant’s name will be given when the artwork is used by the EU Delegation.

9. DATA PROTECTION

- a. The EU Delegation process personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data. - b. By completing the entry form, the contestant agrees to the EU Delegation collecting, processing, storing or otherwise utilising the contestant’s personal data solely for the purposes of conducting and administering the contest, delivering the prizes to the winners and sending communications with information about the contest.
